- CARDIOPULMONARY EXERCISE TESTING (CPET)
- CHEST X-RAY

- POLYSOMNOGRAPHY
- LUNG FUNCTION TESTS (INCL BLOOD GAS ANALYSIS)
- GLYCATED HAEMOGLOBIN TEST
- LIVER FUNCTION TESTS
- CORONARY CT ANGIOGRAPHY



- in case of clinical risk factors according to the cardiac risk index
- in case of cardiovascular or renal disease, if symptoms were not recently examined
- when renal impairment is suspected
- **** if older than 65y

- in case of a chronic liver disease or a history of abnormal bleeding, spontaneous, or after trauma or surgery
- in case of clinical risk factors according to the cardiac risk index and of a poor functional capacity
- ooo in case of urological or prosthesis surgery
- °°°° history of abnormal bleeding, spontaneous, or after trauma or surgery
- Red blood cells (hemoglobin, hematocrit and count), white blood cells (count and formula) and platelets.
- 2 Creatinine, DFG, sodium and potassium.
